H2H Children's Home and School:

There are currently ninety-four children living in our children's home with no new children joining us in January or February. There was significant political unrest in Haiti in February. This unrest stemmed from increased cost of living and the misuse of money loaned to Haiti through Petrocaribe. Although the majority of problems occurred in the big cities, Grand Goave was affected by road closures.

Due to the unrest, our school was closed for over two weeks (February 7th-February 25th). Though news about the unrest has prevailed in early 2019, our children did have some things to look forward to at our compound! Our school hosted an intermural soccer tournament, which was enjoyed by many.



H2H Teams:

Three teams visited Heart to Heart in January and February. Two medical teams did mobile medical clinics and although the February team had to leave early because of the unrest, they were able to see over 1000 patients! Our Education Team leaders visited on business related to their summer Teacher Training Program that we look forward to hosting again in July.
